This document explains what cookies are and how GlobalDF uses them. Please read this document so you can understand GlobalDF's Cookie Policy regarding what type of cookies we use, the information we collect using cookies, and how that information is used.

Cookies do not typically contain any information that personally identifies a user. We do not store sensitive personal information, such as mailing addresses, account passwords, or any other personal information in the cookies we use.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The following definitions have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of GlobalDF's Cookies Policy:

- **Non-Profit Organization ("We", "Us," or "Our" in this Cookies Policy)** refers to the Global Clearinghouse for Development Finance ("GlobalDF"), located at 182 Stissing Road, Stanfordville, NY 12581, USA and at 139 west 82nd Street, New York City, NY, 10022, USA.
- **Cookies** means small files that are placed on your computer, mobile device, or any other device by a website, containing details of your browsing history on that website among its many uses.
- **Website** refers to GlobalDF's website, accessible from globalclearinghouse.org and globaldf.org.
- **You is defined as the individual, company, or any legal vehicle accessing or using GlobalDF's website**, including all individuals accessing or using our website on behalf of other entities as applicable.

Use of Cookies

Type of Cookies We Use

Cookies can be "Persistent" or "Session" cookies. Persistent cookies remain on your personal computer or mobile device when you go offline, while Session Cookies are deleted as soon as you close your web browser.

We use both session and persistent Cookies for the purposes set out below:

Necessary / Essential Cookies

Type: Session Cookies

Purpose: These types of cookies are essential to provide you with services available through the website and to enable you to use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these cookies, the services that you have asked for cannot be provided, and we only use these cookies to provide you with those services.

Functionality Cookies

Type: Persistent Cookies

Purpose: These types of cookies allow the website to remember choices you make when you use GlobalDF's website, such as remembering your login details or preferences. The purpose of these cookies is to provide you with a more personal experience and to avoid you having to re-enter your preferences every time you use GlobalDF's website.

Your Choices Regarding Cookies

If you prefer to avoid the use of cookies on GlobalDF's website, you need to disable the use of cookies in your browser and then delete any cookies saved in your browser associated with this website. You may use this option for preventing the use of cookies at any time. If you do not accept the cookies on GlobalDF's website, you may experience some inconvenience in your use of the website and some features may not function properly.
